Transport Challenge

- Olympic Games 25 (27) July to 12 August
- Paralympic Games 29 August to 9 September
- Summer of Celebration
- 13 Police Force Areas & BTP
- 10 Million Tickets
- Public Transport Games
- 100% Spectators Public Transport, Walk, Cycle
- 80% by Rail, Underground and Light Rail
- No Car Parking at Venues except Disabled





- Best ever connected Olympic Park
- No tolerance of disruption
- 10 Rail and Underground Lines
- 3 Gateway stations
- 13.5 Seconds Between Trains
- 240,000 Hourly Capacity



Olympic Park Rail Demands (2)

- Javelin 7 Minutes to Olympic Park
- 25,000 Javelin Hourly Capacity
- 345,500 Spectators Each Day to Olympic Park
- 269,490 (78%) Rail and Underground
- 58% Stratford Regional Station
- 42% Stratford International and West Ham
