Police were alerted and the claimant was stopped and searched by BTP officers under section 60 Criminal Justice and Public Order Act at Victoria Station. He was then arrested by officers from the Metropolitan Police for a breach of the peace.</p> <p>Solicitors acting for the claimant served notice of their intention to judicially review the search, arrest and detention, as they believed it to be irrational, unlawful, a violation of articles 6, 10, 11 and 14 HRA, and in violation of s29 (6) and s146 of the Equality Act of 2010.</p> <p>Defence was served on 27.06.11 and</p>
