## **1.** Purpose of paper

1.1 To propose and agree the Terms of Reference for the Policing Plan Working Group for the 2011/12 planning cycle.

## 2. Proposed Terms of Reference

- 2.1 To agree the way forward, in terms of context, shape and balance of Plan, to enable the Force to develop of a set of quantitative and qualitative Policing Plan targets for 2011/12.
- 2.2 To receive, consider and comment upon iterations of a Policing Plan as developed by the Force; taking into consideration any evidence gathered through the Force and Authority's stakeholder consultation exercises and other activities.
- 2.3 To agree a draft Policing Plan to be recommended to the full Authority for approval at its March 24<sup>th</sup> 2011 meeting.
- 2.4 In doing so to contribute to meeting the Authority's duties as set out under Sections 50 and 52 of the Railways and Transport Safety Act 2003;

Section 50 Policing objectives

(1) Before the beginning of each financial year the Authority shall set objectives for policing the railways during that year.

Section 52 Railways policing plan

(1) Before the beginning of each financial year the Authority shall issue a plan setting out the proposed arrangements for policing the railways during that year.

# **3.** Critical success factors

- 3.1 All those attending the series of meetings need to come prepared with the same information so that they are able to enter into a meaningful dialogue, and to ask pertinent questions. To this end, both the Authority and the Force will provide written material in advance of each session to support with this process.
- 3.2 To be a success, the meeting must be a two way dialogue so that there is constructive feedback, though this does not mean to say the session cannot be challenging.

## 4. Proposed next steps

- 4.1 As in previous years it is recommended that the Authority now commissions, contributes to and receives draft reports and information in support of the following.
  - A National Plan draft themes and targets to be received at the next meeting of the Group on 10<sup>th</sup> December for discussion and scrutiny. These targets to be informed by representations made at the stakeholder workshop on 28<sup>th</sup> September 2010.
  - Further written consultation with stakeholders on a draft of the National Plan to be led by the Authority following the next meeting on 10<sup>th</sup> December. Feedback to be reported and any subsequent amendments considered at the Group's meeting on 21<sup>st</sup> February.
  - Local Area Plans draft themes and targets to be considered and scrutinised at the Group's meeting on 21<sup>st</sup> February.
  - Drafts of the National and Local Area Plans to be recommended for further discussion and scrutiny at the full Authority meeting on 24<sup>th</sup> March.

#### 5. Recommendations

5.1 That Members note and approve the Terms of Reference and proposed next steps as set out in sections 2 and 4 above.
