1. Purpose of Paper

1.1 The purpose of this report is to inform the Audit Committee of significant developments within the Executive since the last Audit Committee in December 2012.

2. Annual Accounts

- 2.1 The MAR for the 2012/13 has been prepared and is presented at agenda item 6. It will to be submitted to the DfT in line with the timetable by 19 April 2013 at the latest.
- 2.2 The NAO have completed their systems Audit. A paper of preliminary findings is presented to the Audit Committee at agenda item 8. The auditors additionally visited the Authority to audit the unauthorised pensions and the work that has taken place this year.
- 2.3 Work has commenced on pulling the annual report together for the year end accounts, which, along with the audited numbers, will be presented to the Audit Committee in May.

3. PSAs from 1 April 2013

- 3.1 The PSA approved by DfT Ministers have been issued to PSA holders for signature. At the time of writing the report two have been received back. The deadline is 21 March.
- 3.2 PSA holders may refuse to sign the new PSA, the progress on signature will be better known at the time of the meeting. An update will be given at the meeting.
- 3.3 The risk to the Authority is that the model will be challenged through arbitration and therefore PSA holders may refuse to pay charges, despite the clause in the PSA requesting payment in full by direct debit.
- 3.4 The charging model is now been refreshed for the proxies applicable for the 2013/14 charges. An external consultant has been employed to independently review the numbers to add comfort that the data has been extracted correctly. Governance around the review and calculation of the charges will be evidenced by a sign off sheet before being publication. The revised charges will be scrutinised by the Finance Group on 19 March before being presented to the Authority on 21 March.

4. Budget 2012/13

- 4.1 Although time consuming the additional approval process required by the DfT was working relatively smoothly up until Christmas. Clare Moriarty has now taken over responsibility for approvals at the DfT and the Chief Executive is meeting with her to discuss the contingent labour and consultancy requests.
- 4.2 Redundancy amounts also require approval and this is now being done within the DfT HR department as the Cabinet Office has agreed that they now have the delegated authority. The turnaround on these requests is now much quicker.

- 4.3 The grant in aid cash settlement have now been finalised and, subject to any last minute audit adjustments on Olympic Expenditure, this should be settled in full by the end of the financial year.
- 4.4 The grant in aid expected to be received for 2012/13 is summarised in the below table:

4.5 The Revenue and capital DEL for 2013/14 has been agreed at £3.6m and £11.2m respectively. Discussions continue on whether there is any additional funding available to finance the nationwide cable theft initiative. The 2013/14 letter of delegation from the DfT to the Chief Executive is awaited.

5. Pension Issues

There are number of issues regarding pensions which are being worked on.

- 5.1 Real time information and Auto enrolment are being dealt with by BTP. It was agreed at the last Authority that the existing pension schemes would be used for auto enrolment.
- 5.2 The work in recovering debtors regarding the pension's contribution errors have been started by BTP HR. An update on progress is included in the Director of Corporate Resources report.

- 5.3 Work has started reviewing the assumptions in the police officers pension scheme valuation and the initial results will be presented to the Authority in June
- 5.4 The structure of the scheme was presented to members in January, work has now commenced on reviewing the structure and the impact of the Hutton review on the Home Office police officer schemes.
- 5.5 The tax liability agreed to be paid on behalf of the 18 members in receipt of unauthorised pension payments is being progressed. Cheques of £217k have been issued to the HMRC for the agreed amounts that BTPA have settled for 2010/11 and 2011/12. Two employees have not yet received their unique tax reference from HMRC and await payment to be settled but the large settlements have been made. It has been very time consuming and the individuals involved have had inconsistent and at times frustrating support from the HMRC. This is being dealt with by the Authority Finance Director and should run more smoothly in future years. The issue of grossing up the payments is being pursued by the Chief Executive with HMRC Technical. Prudent assumptions will be made with providing for the outstanding liability at the year end.

6. Internal Audit

6.1 Tribal have worked with us for 4 years and their contract comes to an end in March 2013. Thereafter the DfT will perform our internal audit function. I would like to thank Andrew Townsend and his team for the support and work completed over the last four years, it has sometimes been a challenging time and the support that we have received has been excellent. I am sure the Audit Committee will join me in thanking Tribal and to welcoming the DfT to continue the role 6.2 DfT have held meetings with both BTP and BTPA. A draft internal audit plan for 2013/14 is presented at agenda item 11 for approval.

7. HMIC

- 7.1 As agreed by this Committee in 2012, BTP and BTPA continue to work with Her Majesty's Inspectorate of Constabulary (HMIC) through an annual protocol to clarify budget and inspection programme for the year ahead. The refreshed protocol and proposed inspection plan for 2013/14 was due to be presented to this meeting of the Audit Committee for formal approval; however significant changes in both personnel and the general approach to inspection planning at HMIC this year means that HMIC's own business plan has not been circulated yet and it is this document on which we base our own bespoke inspection programme.
- 7.2 Both the Authority and BTP have been in regular contact with HMIC to ensure the protocol is developed at the earliest opportunity and work has been carried out to allocate a budget for inspection activity and to identify likely areas of inspection which so far include the value for money/report card exercise and a likely revisit on Stop & Search. We propose to continue to work with HMIC over the coming weeks and, before the next Audit meeting in May, circulate the protocol and plan to members for comments/approval out of committee. The decision regarding the proposals can be recorded in the BTPA quarterly report for that meeting.

8. Gifts and Hospitality Register

- 8.1 In line with good governance in public bodies, a copy of the Gifts and Hospitality which have been received, accepted or declined by BTPA Members and BTPA Executive Senior Staff for oversight is prepared. Appendix A lists the full details for the BTPA.
- 8.2 The Chief Executive has also reviewed the BTP Gifts and Hospitality Register with the Deputy Chief Constable which is attached at Appendix B.
- 8.3 Members are asked to note the gifts and hospitality register.

9. Recommendations

9.1 Members are asked to note this report.

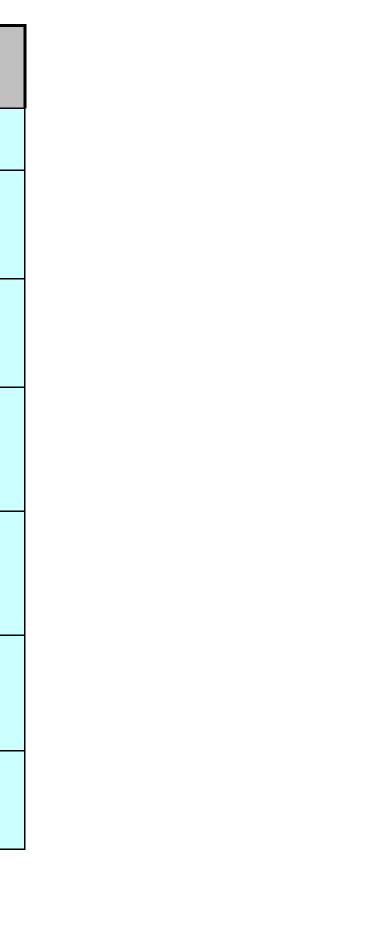

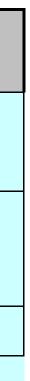
