Dalcross to get railway link

Inverness Airport could get its own railway station in little more than a year, it emerged yesterday.

Transport Minister Keith Brown revealed in a parliamentary answer that the disused Dalcross station will open for business between 2014 and 2019.

The Scottish Government has been working with Network Rail to reopen Dalcross as part of improvements to the Aberdeen-Inverness rail line that passes the airport's southern boundary.
