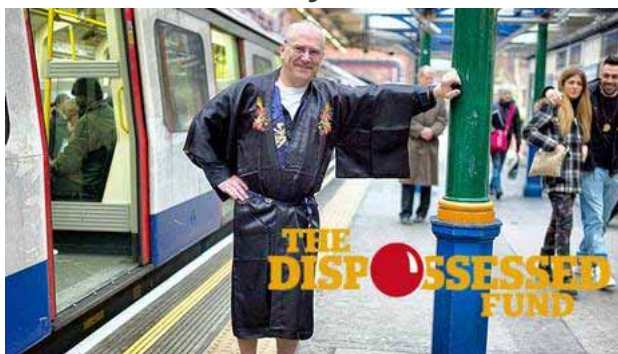




Kimo-no! It is Tube boss Hendy in his PJs for Red Nose Day

London's transport boss today urged commuters to follow in his example by wearing their pyjamas on the Tube.

Sir Peter Hendy went to work in full nightwear including slippers and an elaborate oriental silk dressing gown.

Everyone in the capital is being urged to support the Evening Standard's Dispossessed Fund campaign for Comic Relief by wearing their pyjamas on Red Nose Day - including to work - to raise money for Londoners in poverty.

The campaign is supported by a host of celebrities including singer Paloma Faith and comedian Russell Kane.

The transport commissioner said the campaign was a "great way" to support the event on March 15 and said he would welcome pyjama-clad commuters on all forms of public transport including Tubes, trains and buses.

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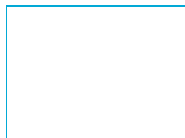
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
