Rutland's Police and Crime Commissioner has promised to tackle safety issues faced by the lesbian, gay, bisexual and transgender community.

Sir Clive Loader and his chief executive Paul Stock met the Leicester LGBT Centre on Tuesday last week.

Board members told the commissioner they wanted equality over special consideration.

After the meeting Sir Clive said: "All officers should understand the issues, and I will do my best to drive that.

"I am very grateful for the opportunity to meet the group, and will be back on May 20 to a meeting of the community safety forum. It's all about building trust and building relationships that are conducive to sharing information and views."
