As well as Hammersmith & Fulham, the plans also cover land in Brent, Ealing and Kensington & Chelsea. Mayor Boris Johnson, Transport for London and three of the councils have jointly drawn up the initial proposals, which would take 30 years to deliver.

The plan could turn Old Oak Common - one of London's least attractive areas, with its train depots and waste recycling facilities — into one of Britain's best-connected locations. Isabel Dedring, deputy mayor for transport, said: "It is a true opportunity area, ideally placed to act as an interchange with Crossrail and other national mainlines, relieving pressure on Euston station.

"A super transport hub in this location would drive significant regeneration in the surrounding area and support the creation of thousands of new jobs and new homes

The deadline for responses to the consultation is Friday. September 6.
