

Prevent assaults on rail staff and increase positive outcomes; ensuring that there is effective communication with victims throughout. Prevent violence, serious public order offences and anti-social behaviour.

Safeguard the public and reduce delay on the railway by reducing trespass incidents at hotspot locations. Maintain an average handback time of under 90 minutes for non-suspicious fatal incidents.
